

Workshop location:

Workshop will be held in Lloyd building in Trinity College Dublin, in room Lloyd 1.07. When you enter the building take the lift or stairs on your right-hand side up to the first floor and follow the signs for 1.07 from there. Trinity is positioned in the heart of city centre and map of campus can be found on <http://www.tcd.ie/Maps/assets/pdf/tcd-main-campus.pdf>. Entrances to the college which are closest to Lloyd building are from Pearse street or Lincoln place.

Meals:

Please let me know (by replying to this email by May 17th) if you have any specific dietary requirements, so I can make sure they're catered for at workshop lunches/dinner.

Accommodation:

The hotels closest to Lloyd building are Alexander (www.alexanderhotel.ie), Mont Clare (www.montclarehotel.ie/), Davenport (www.davenporthotel.ie/), Pearse hotel (www.pearsehotel.com/) and Trinity Capital Hotel (<http://www.trinitycapitalhotel.com>). All of these hotels are also very close to Dublin Convention Centre where ITS Congress is being held so I'd advise booking your accommodation ASAP as availability could be limited. If you're staying for the Congress and would prefer a hotel closer to the Convention Centre, some of the hotel options are Maldron Cardiff Lane (www.maldronhotelcardifflane.com), The Marker (www.themarkerhoteldublin.com/), and Clarion (www.clarionhotelifsc.com/). Trinity College and the Convention Centre are about 10-15 minutes walk away from each other.

Airport transport

There are a couple of buses going to city centre - Aircoach (www.aircoach.ie/) can drop you off at the Front gate of Trinity and Airlink (<http://www.dublinbus.ie/PageFiles/7285/Airlink%20Brochure.pdf>) goes to the Convention Centre. Price of a one-way ticket is 6-8 euro. Taxi into city centre costs about 25 euro one way.
